झुकला औरंग्या म्हणे कैसा हा छावा

ऐसा मर्द मराठा पुन्हा पुन्हा जन्माला यावा

शिवपुत्र संभजी महाराजांचा जीवनप्रवास म्हणजे एक अग्निदिव्य. छत्रपतींच्या निधनानंतर औरंगजेब पाच लाखांचे सैन्य व चौदा कोटींचा खजिना घेऊन दख्खन जिंकायला निघाला. पण छत्रपती संभाजी महाराजांनी त्याला नऊ वर्षे निकराचा लढा देऊन जेरीस आणला. दख्खन जिंकायला निघालेल्या या कुर औरंगजेबाला पुन्हा दिल्लीच्या तख्तावर विराजमान होता आलं नाही.

लेखक शिवाजी सावंत यांनी छावा सन १९७२ साली लिहायला घेतलं. लिखाणाच्या पहिल्याच दिवशी जगदंबेने कसा कौल दिना याबद्दल त्यांनी प्रस्तावनेत लिहलं आहे. किल्ले प्रतापगडावर १९७९ साली यशवंतराव चव्हाण यांच्या हस्ते छावा प्रकाशित झालं आणि महाराष्ट्राच्या जनतेने या पुस्तकाला अक्षरशः डोक्यावर घेतलं. छत्रपती संभजी महाराजांच्या जन्मापासून या कादंबरीची सुरुवात होते. पुस्तकातील भाषेचा प्रभव आहे. लेखकाने ज्या पध्दतीने पात्रांच्या मनाचा कौल घेण्याचा प्रयत्न केला आहे तो विशेष. प्रत्येक वाक्य प्रत्येक शब्द तुमच्या मनाला भिडत राहतो आणि शंभुकाळ तुमच्या डोळ्यांसमारे उभा राहतो. काही प्रसंग लेखकाने इतके उत्तम लिहिले आहेत कि तुम्ही गडावर आहात आणि सर्व घडामोडी तुमच्या डोळ्यांदेखत घडत आहेत असा भास होतो.

संभजीराजे पुस्तक जरी संभाजी महाराजांवर असलं तरीही विवराचांचे पराक्रम संक्षिप्त स्वरूपात आहेत कारण शंभुराजे मोठे होत असताना छत्रपती शिवाजीराजे स्वराज्य वाढवत होते आणि अनेक संकटांचा सामना करत होते. छत्रपती संभजीराजांना वयाच्या नऊ व्या वर्षी आग-याला जावं लागलं आणि तेथून त्यांची आणि नाजकारणाची ओळख झाली.

संभाजीराजे शूर योद्धे तर होतेच त्याबरोबरच जे कविमनाचे देखील होते. त्यांनी संस्कृतमध्ये बुध्दभूषणम काव्यरचना केली. एक योद्धा कवी असणे हि एक दुर्मिळ आणि विलक्षण गोष्ट. एकाचवेळी पाच आघाडयांवर झुंझ देणारा भारतातील किंवा कदाचित जगातील एकमेव धुरंधर सेनानी. शंभुराजे एकाचवेळी जंजिरेकर सिद्दी, इंग्रज, गोव्याचे फिरंग, मयूर औरंगजेब आणि स्वराज्यातील फितून यासर्वांशी लढत होते. म्हणूनच शंभुराजांना स्वराज्यरक्षक म्हणतात.

श्री शंभो : शिवजातस्य मुद्रा घौरिव राजते ।

यदंकसेविनी लेखा वर्तते कस्य नोपरि ।

फितुरीमुळे शंभुराजांना झालेली अटक मनाला सलते आणि त्यांच्यावर झालेल्या अत्याचार वाचून हदयावर अणुकुचीदार शस्त्राने सपासप वार होता आहेत असं वाटतं. जगाच्या पाठीवर कोणत्या राजाने सोसल्या नाहीत त्या यातना या छाव्याने सोसल्या पण मग्नर औरंग्यासमोर शंभूराजे झुकले नाहीत.

लेखकाने संभजीराजांच्या शौर्याला, त्यागाला पुरेपूर न्याय दिला आहे. तत्कालीन स्वराज्याच वर्णन अप्रतिम पध्दतीने केलं आहे. या पुस्तकातून सध्या बऱ्याच चित्रपट आणि मालिकांमध्ये संदर्भ घेतल्याचं जाणवत.

पुस्तकाचा विषय, भाषेच लहेजा, प्रसंगवर्णन, पराक्रम, त्याग लेखकाचा अभ्यास आणि निष्ठा या सर्व गोष्टींचा सारासार विचार करता छावा हे मराठी साहित्यातील शिरोमणी आहे. खंत हीच वाटते की शंभूराजांच बलिदान लोकांपर्यंत पोहचले नाही आणि म्हणूनच प्रत्येकाने छावा एकदातरी जरूर वाचावे आणि हा इतिहास इतरांपर्यंत देखील पोचवावा.




