





# ENGLISH ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

To enhance cognitive skill of the students teachers had kept different activity for them.




"बटाट्याची चाळ" हे पु. ल. देशपांडे यांचे अतिशय लोकप्रिय आणि मराठी साहित्यविश्वातील एक अमूल्य पुस्तक आहे. या पुस्तकात मुंबईच्या जुन्या चाळीतील जीवन, तिथले विविध स्वभावाचे आणि रंगीबेरंगी लोक, त्यांच्या कथा, हास्य-विनोद, आणि चाळ संस्कृतीचे अद्वितीय चित्रण अतिशय रसाळ, हलक्याफुलक्या शैलीत केले आहे.

### लेखकाचे निरीक्षण:

पु. ल. देशपांडे यांची सूक्ष्म निरीक्षणशक्ती आणि पात्रांचे अचूक, व्यंगप्रधान रेखाटन वाचकांना खिळवून ठेवते. प्रत्येक पात्र (जसे की सोकाजी दादा, आचार्य बर्वे, अण्णा पावशे, काशिनाथ नाडकर्णी आदि) आपल्या सहज संवादातून चाळीतल्या वातावरणाला जिवंत करतात.

### शैली आणि वैशिष्ट्ये:

पुलंची लेखनशैली अत्यंत विनोदी, परंतु त्यात सामाजिक भाष्य आणि मार्मिकता ही आहे. साध्या घटनांतून, भाजीवरून झालेले वाद, शेजाच्यांमधील गमतीजमती, चाळीतील सण-वार, अवखळपणा आणि दुःख-सुख यात त्यांचा विनोद वाचकांच्या मनाला भिडतो. हे पुस्तक केवळ हसवत नाही, तर जुनी जीवनशैली, आपुलकी, माणुसकी आणि हरवलेली चाळ-संस्कृती समोर घेऊन येते.

### भावनिक टोन:

## निष्कर्षः




